



Week of Action to Target Residents' Concerns

Devon police will be out in force for 'Operation Everest' - a week of action from 31 October to 6 November 2010.

The main aim of the operation is to work with partner agencies to reduce anti social behaviour, offer crime prevention advice and engage with local residents to understand their concerns.

By day activities will focus on community initiatives and events to address the priorities set in each neighbourhood, including activities such as community speedwatch, crime prevention advice, street briefings and anti social behaviour patrols.

By night the focus shifts to high visibility patrols, particularly on Halloween and bonfire night to ensure both events are enjoyed safely and peacefully across Devon.

Neighbourhood teams have been liaising with schools and retailers to offer advice on firework safety and trick-or-treating. They have been reassuring elderly and vulnerable residents and distributing posters to provide information and deter unwanted trick-or-treaters.

Devon's Chief Superintendent Jo Tennant said: "The activities taking place are in response to feedback from the public about what matters to them at this time of the year. It's about the police understanding the concerns of local people and letting them know what we and our partners are doing to address them. We value the support of our communities and we ask that the public stop and speak to our officers to inform them of their issues."
